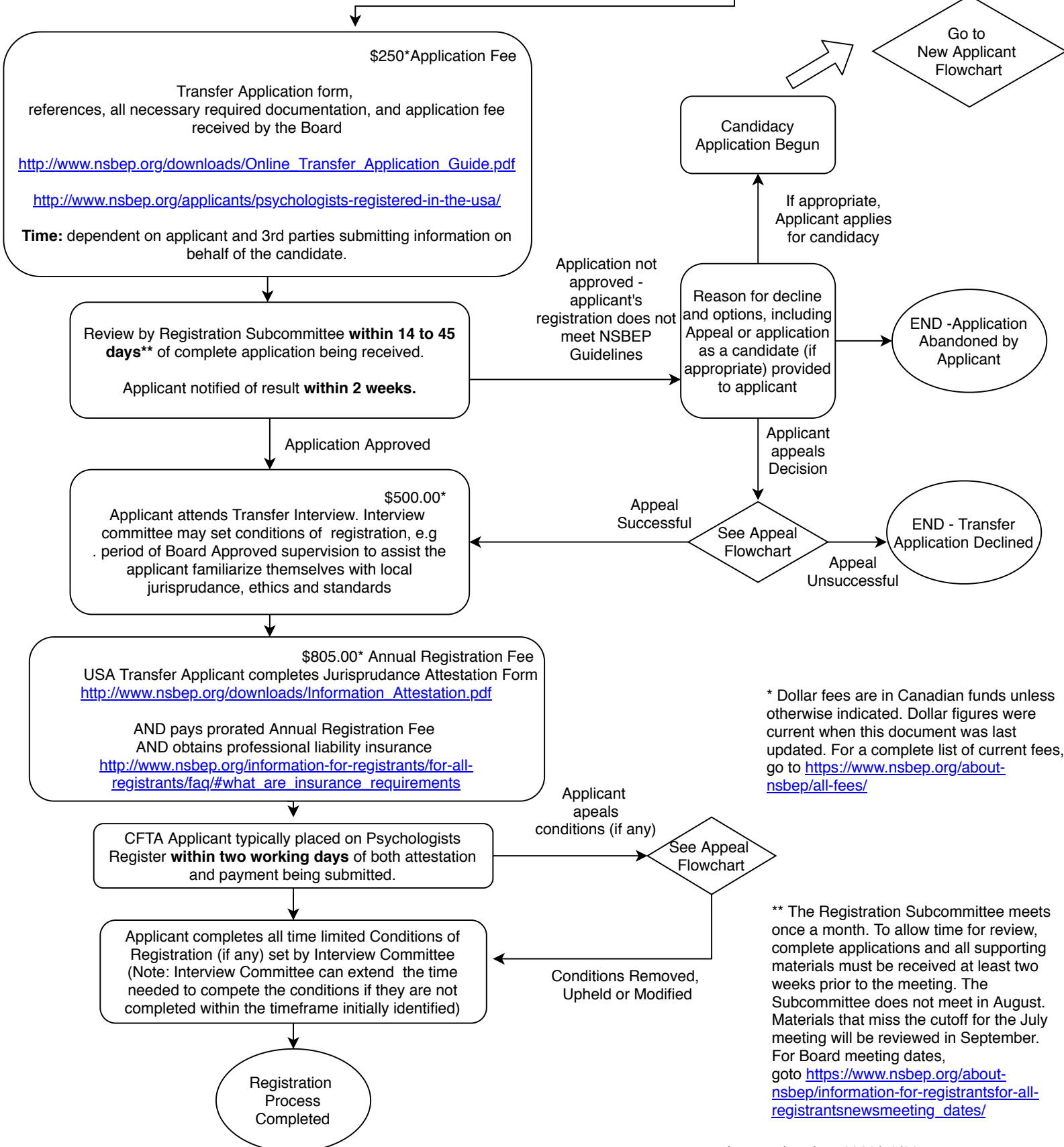


Transfer Application for Psychologist Registered in a US Jurisdiction

Applicant is fully registered for independent practice as a psychologist in a US jurisdiction with at least equivalent licensure requirements to Nova Scotia and meets the criteria described in <http://www.nsbep.org/applicants/psychologists-registered-in-the-usa/>
